IBDP 2021-22

Scholarships may be presented in the three percentages of the annual school fee: **25%, 50% or 75%**, depending upon the evaluated **'need'** of an applicant. The scholarship will be awarded only on the tuition fees, it will not be applicable to Examination fees, CAS trip, Books, Laptop, Calculator and other expenses incurred during the two years of the IBDP programme .

***Academic Scholarship: ‘Minimum Eligibility Criterion’**

The students who have persistently achieved high academic grades/scores and are interested in applying for scholarship. To be eligible to apply, students must meet the following **‘Minimum Eligibility Criterion’** in grade 10.

Curriculum	Minimum Eligibility Criterion
CBSE	Achievement grade that translates into a CGPA of 9.0 or 95 % and above.
ICSE and SSC	95% and above.
IGCSE	Minimum 5 A* and not more than one C
